But we cannot recruit, form, and train the many young men who are aspiring and responding to the call of God to be the priests and lay Brothers of the Apostles of Jesus without the collaboration, support, and involvement of the laity. The church, and indeed, the Apostles of Jesus want you to be collaborators of our missionary formation, prayers, and in any way that you feel the Holy Spirit is inspiring you.

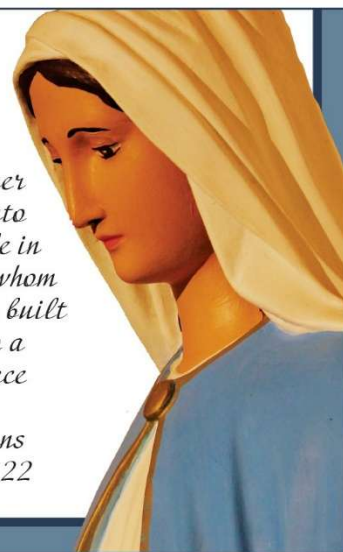
