Archbishop Sample will lead a Holy Hour at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Portland on Saturday, January 29, 2022, at 11:00 A. M.

Why did Jesus, the all-holy Son of God, seek John's baptism of repentance? It was not to receive – for he is himself the source of all grace - but to give.
