STATEWIDE HOLY HOUR OF EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Archbishop Sample will lead a Holy Hour at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Portland on Saturday, January 29, 2022, at 11:00 A. M.

The prayer intentions for the Holy Hour include requesting divine guidance for the Synodal process called for by Pope Francis, a deeper appreciation of the dignity and sacredness of human life, an end to abortion, and a renewed spirit and light for all parishes and parishioners in the Portland and Baker Dioceses.

Why did Jesus, the all-holy Son of God, seek John's baptism of repentance? It was not to receive – for he is himself the source of all grace - but to give. “Christ is baptized, not to be made holy by the water, but to make the water holy, and by his cleansing to purify the waters which he touched” (St. Maximus of Turin). Christ's baptism reveals to us what our own baptism now accomplishes: the forgiveness of sin and a share in his divine sonship.
