Archbishop Sample will lead a Holy Hour at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Portland on Saturday, January 29, 2022, at 11:00 A. M.

The prayer intentions for the Holy Hour include requesting divine guidance for the Synodal process called for by Pope Francis, a deeper appreciation of the dignity and sacredness of human life, an end to abortion, and a renewed spirit and light for all parishes and parishioners in the Portland and Baker Dioceses.
