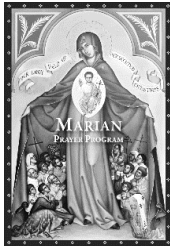
Please join us at 4:30 pm this Friday for the Marian Prayer Service with the Rosary. The Icon will remain through the Saturday Vigil Mass.
