Blessing during the Distribution of Holy Communion

The Archbishop has asked the office of Divine Worship to communicate the decision of the Presbyteral Council concerning the issue of blessings during the distribution of Holy Communion.



The decision is that when a member of the faithful approaches a minister (ordinary or extraordinary) indicating that they will not be receiving Holy Communion, the minister is to say to them “May Christ be with you” or “Cristo esté contigo.” There should be no gesture, just the words as given. *It is inadvisable for ministers to touch the person in any way.* All the faithful are encouraged to make a sign of reverence as they approach the Blessed Sacrament even if not receiving, in the United States this has been determined to be a bow of the head. [General Instruction of the Roman Missal #160]


