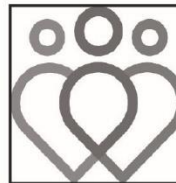

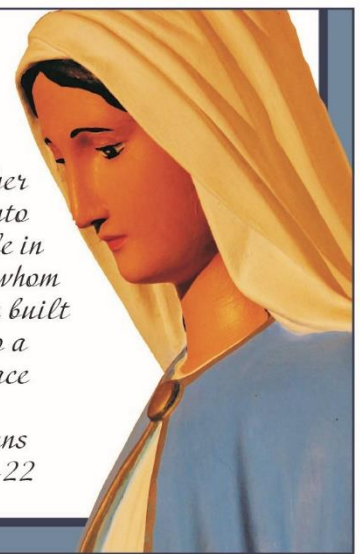

Baptism: You must be registered and active members in the parish for a minimum of 6 months and a Baptism preparation class is required.
