### Bendición durante la distribución de la Sagrada comunión

El arzobispo ha pedido a la oficina de culto divino que comunique la decisión del Concilio presbiterio concerniente a la cuestión de las bendiciones durante la distribución de la Sagrada comunión.



La decisión es que cuando un miembro de los fieles se acerca a un ministro (ordinario o extraordinario) indicando que no recibirá la Sagrada comunión, el ministro les dirá "Cristo esté contigo". No debe haber ningún gesto, sólo las palabras dadas. *No es aconsejable que los ministros toquen a la persona de ninguna manera.* Se alienta a todos los fieles a que hagan un signo de reverencia al acercarse al Santísimo Sacramento, aun cuando no reciban la Eucaristía, en los Estados Unidos, esto ha sido determinado inclinar la cabeza. [Es una Instrucción general del Misal Romano #160]
