Lent and the Paschal Triduum, 2025

Fasting and Abstinence Reminders:

† All Catholics 14 years and older must abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

† All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Good Friday.

To fast means to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken for good health, but together they should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted; however, liquids including coffee, milk and fruit juices are allowed.

The faithful are also encouraged to receive the Sacrament of Penance during Lent.



Don't forget that daylight saving time begins on Sunday, Mar. 9th. Set clocks forward one hour on Saturday evening.

In the words of Pope Francis

- Fast from hurting words and say kind words.
- Fast from sadness and be filled with gratitude.

- Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity.
- Fast from pressures and be prayerful.
- Fast from bitterness and fill your hearts with joy.
- Fast from selfishness and be compassionate to others.
- Fast from grudges and be reconciled.
- Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.

Ideas for Lent:

- 1) This is a great time to build a prayer habit.
- 2) Ask for strength to do God's will.
- 3) Attend at least one Stations of the Cross to pray with others.
- 4) Reflect on your sins and ask for forgiveness.
- 5) Consider how you can help others.
- 6) Ask for help to forgive those who caused you pain.

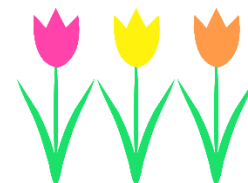

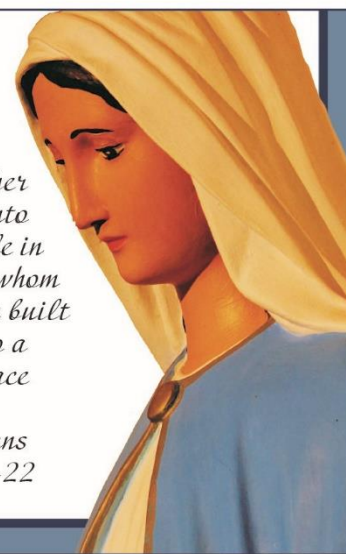
