During Lent, we choose acts of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving to bring us closer to Christ. As the Feast of St. Joseph falls on March 19th, we can all start a Novena today (Sunday, March 10). What to pray? One traditional devotion we have is to meditate on the Seven Sorrows of St. Joseph (see flyer). Knowing these Seven Sorrows can also strengthen our hearts to carry with joy our own personal crosses. Such a spiritual devotion for nine days will contribute to our Lenten offerings of Prayer.

Today, the Sunday School children will have class as usual, from 11:45am to 12:45pm in the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton classroom (middle room). We will make a short visit to the Sanctuary to identify important items in the church. Class will be held at the regular time next week as well. 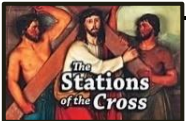
