To qualify for the national scholarships, the recipient must be either the son or daughter of a Knight of Columbus or deceased Knight of Columbus, or a Knight of Columbus themselves. The recipient must also be entering a 4-year program at a Catholic college or Catholic university in the United States. Most of these scholarships are renewable each year.

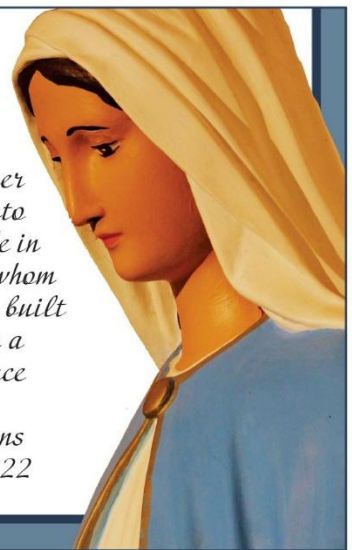
