### Kevin Leahy Memory-

I vividly remember during Lent all the students at Star of the Sea School would go to daily mass. We would first meet in our classrooms and then starting with the first grade all the way to the 12th we would walk in single file to St Mary's Church and go in row by row by class. The entire right side of church would be full with students, and parishioners on the left!

After mass, we would return to our classrooms and have breakfast, as we had a three hour fasting rule then and breakfast at 5:00 am was a little too early for my family!

My Mom made the best fried egg sandwiches which my classmates tried to barter with me on, but I never gave in!
