Memory from Donna Van Velzer

Our family moved to Astoria in 1958 when my dad took a position at KVAS radio. My older brother and I started school at Star of the Sea and our family became members of St. Mary's.

When my younger siblings were school age, our Mom, Donna Van Velzer, took a job in the school cafeteria and cooked for school kids for 26 years. Her most memorable experience at Star was when the kitchen staff smelled smoke from down the hallway. Mom went to investigate and found a mop leaning against the furnace in the boiler room smoking. All she thought about was to get it outside. Grabbing the mop, she ran through the gym to the closest exit, and in doing so fanned the flames.

Custodian and friend, Jerry Davis, was in close pursuit and quickly doused the fire. The playground across the street was full of kids at recess. Nobody noticed and Mom and Jerry agree to tell no one for fear of getting in trouble...their secret, their story!
