The Amazing Parish leadership team just concluded a Bible study on the Eucharist with materials from Augustine Institute that was facilitated by Ed Johnson and Linda Sitkowski.

The Eucharist is the keystone of our Catholic faith. The study was fascinating, taking us on a journey from Genesis through Revelation. We are familiar with the gospel of John, chapter 6, where at the Passover meal Jesus blesses the bread and says, 'Take, eat, this is my body.'

Saint Francis De Sales wrote "Our Savior has instituted the most august sacrament of the Eucharist...to the end he who eats of it shall live forever. Whoever, therefore, frequently eats with devotion this food so effectually confirms the health of his soul that it is almost impossible that he should be poisoned by any kind of evil affection".

The parishioners who attended found the study life changing. We intend to offer the Eucharist study again in the fall.


