August 1 – 4, 2022

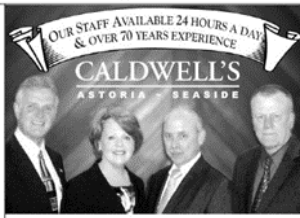
