{Please sign up for weekend Masses by noon on Friday}

1. A general dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation is still in place.
2. Please use hand sanitizer upon entering the church.
3. Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feelings of sickness must remain home.
4. **Face coverings are required for adults and children over the age of 5.** If you are unable to wear a mask due to a health condition or disability, you may be able to get an exemption from a medical doctor. Please make this known (badges are being worn) at check-in for Mass and we will direct you on where to sit.
5. If you are attending a Mass at St. Mary, please enter through the 15<sup>th</sup> Street entrance. The main entrance will only be open for exiting.
6. Maintain social distancing of 6 ft. apart.
7. Please sit on the pews marked with blue tape.
8. An offertory basket will be available at the entrance of the churches for parish offerings...thank you.
9. Those who would like to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, we kindly ask that you wait until the end of the line to present yourself.
10. We would like everyone to wipe down their area and if you are unable to, leave DOWN the kneeler and our cleaners will know to take care of it.
11. Please exit the church at the conclusion of Mass.

- 1) Todavía existe una dispensa general de la obligación de la Misa Dominical.
