Here are a few suggestions on what to do during Eucharistic Adoration.

MEDITATE USING SCRIPTURE

Choose a passage from the Bible. Read the words and ask God to let the passage speak to you. Pay special attention to anything that strikes you and ask God what He wishes for you to draw from that passage.

READ THE LIFE OF A SAINT AND PRAY WITH HIM OR HER

Read about them and pray their prayers before the Blessed Sacrament.

POUR OUT YOUR HEART TO CHRIST AND ADORE HIM

Speak to Jesus, aware that you are in His presence, and tell Him all that comes to your mind. Listen for His response.

ASK FOR FORGIVENESS AND INTERCEDE FOR OTHERS

Think of those who have hurt you and request a special blessing for them. Ask God to forgive you for all the times you have neglected or hurt someone else. Bring before the Blessed Sacrament all those who have asked you to pray for them. Ask the Lord to address their concerns.

PRAY THE ROSARY

Ask Mary to join you as you gaze on Christ in the Eucharist and as you pray the Rosary.

SIT QUIETLY AND JUST "BE" IN THE PRESENCE OF GOD

Think of a visit to the Blessed Sacrament as coming to see your best friend. Sit quietly and enjoy being in each other's company.

I recently attended a reunion of St. Joseph Circle of the Altar Society. Seeing old friends and thinking of past members brought to mind many memories.

When I moved to Astoria as a young bride in 1968, one of the first people I met was Katherine (Katie) Antonich Wilson. She invited me and several other women to a meeting at her house. This group became St. Joseph Circle. Each circle had a money-making project. The funds earned went to the Altar Society to pay for candles and other altar supplies. St. Joseph's project was an Easter bake sale. We did this for many years in addition to participating in weekly church cleaning, attending Altar Society meetings, and helping at the annual rummage sale. We also had a booth at the parish bazaar.


