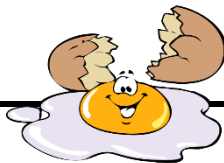
ALL SOULS DAY

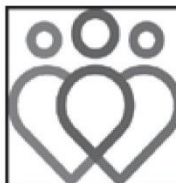
