~MASS REMINDERS~

1. A general dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation is still in place.
2. Please use hand sanitizer upon entering the church.
3. Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feelings of sickness must remain home.

8. For those who would like to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, we kindly ask that you wait until the end of the line to present yourself.
9. Please wipe down your pew after Mass. If you are unable to, leave your kneeler down and a cleaner will do it for you.
10. We encourage everyone to refrain from excessively touching surfaces.
11. Please exit the church at the conclusion of Mass through the main entrance.
