#### **Absences**

If your child will be absent from class, please contact Amy at the Parish Offices at (503) 325-3671, or Rosy at (503) 459-2331. It is especially important for those students who <u>ride the bus</u> because we verify our kids as they get off the bus.

#### <u>Snacks</u>

Your child will be given a snack after Mass at every class. We would appreciate any donations of healthy snacks. Example: Goldfish, graham crackers, granola bars. You may drop off snacks at the Parish Office at 1465 Grand, Ave., M-F, 8:30 AM-4PM. No juice boxes please.

#### **Class Dismissal and Pick Up**

Please pick up your child in the auditorium promptly at 4:30, unless you must pick him/her up early. With the exception of a prearranged ongoing early pickup, please give advance notice. When you arrive, you must call your child's teacher (numbers listed below) in order that your k-4 child can be dismissed and accompanied to the 14<sup>th</sup> STREET ENTRANCE to meet you. (The auditorium remains locked until dismissal.)

If a parent is not picking up their child, the authorized adult is to sign the child out for the day. Please be sure the adult's name is on the "End of the Day" release form which is attached to the registration form. Parents may add names if needed throughout the year.

#### Dress code

Students will be attending Mass during the program and sometimes participating in the Mass as well. Please be sure your child is dressed appropriately as he/she enters the House of God. Be sure to send your child with a jacket WITH IDENTIFICATION. The weather is always changing. Rain or shine, we will be walking to Mass. (If a personal item is left behind, it will be taken to the church office where you can retrieve it.)

#### **Volunteers**

Dana Berny, Helen Dessen, and Emily Borup are the regular volunteers in our program. Kathy Arndt, Sheila Miller, and Bev Crosby volunteer as assistants and substitutes. Also, we have student volunteers, middle and high school, who offer invaluable help on the playground, in church, preparing and serving snacks and assisting in the classroom.
